NUMBER OF MEMBERS:	Eleven (11)
APPOINTED BY:	City Council
COMPOSED OF:	Mayor and Council Members and four residents of the City appointed at large. The appointees shall be residents of the City, may not have a personal interest in any contract executed by the District, shall comply with Chapter 171, Texas Local Government Code, and it is preferred that the member have experience in economic development, real estate and/or business practices.
TERM OF OFFICE:	Two years—Terms of Mayor and Council are consistent with the term as Mayor or Council Member. The at-large members will serve two-year terms, except two of the initial members will serve one-year terms.
MEETINGS:	When necessary
COMPENSATION:	None.
DUTIES:	Manage the Baytown Municipal Development District, approve projects of the District.
