COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: Nine (9)

APPOINTED BY: By Ordinance No. 5083 adopted August 25, 1988, City Council makes appointments (amended March 25, 1993, by Ordinance No. 6573) (amended March 23, 1995, by Ordinance No. 7268, deleted term limits)

COMPOSED OF: Nine (9) members and one (1) youth member; and shall have representation of low- to moderate-income areas of the city, as defined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Minority groups will at least be represented in proportion to such citywide percentage representation. The committee shall consist of at least one member from each of the six council districts and three (3) positions at large, in addition to one (1) youth member between the ages of 14 -18.

EX-OFFICIO SECRETARY: The City Community Development Planner

TERMS OF OFFICE: Two (2) year terms: five (5) members appointed in odd numbered years; four (4) members appointed in even numbered years and the youth member shall be appointed for one (1) year terms.

DUTIES: The committee shall hold public hearings and make reports as required in the Citizen Participation Plan.
