

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.70042 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Baytown.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.70042 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.69803 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.77270 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Baytown from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that City of Baytown may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Baytown is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 25, 2025 AT 6:30p.m. AT 2401 Market St., Council Chamber, City Hall, Baytown, Texas 77520.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, City of Baytown is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of City of Baytown at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE
CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Baytown last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Baytown this year.
