designee, one (1) licensed veterinarian, one (1) representative from an animal welfare organization, and three (3) interested citizens, who shall not have any professional or personal affiliations similar to those

represented by other appointees to the committee.

TERM OF OFFICE: Two (2) years - The initial appointment of the licensed

veterinarian shall be for a two-year term, and the initial appointment of the representative of an animal welfare organization and an interested citizen shall be a one-year

term. (Subsequent terms are two years.)

MEETINGS: When necessary

COMPENSATION: None

DUTIES: Assist the Baytown Animal Shelter to comply with applicable

law; formulate future animal control plans, strategies, education, and to recommend revision in the animal control

ordinances.
