COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Community Development Transportation Program is sponsored by the City of Baytown Community Development Block Grant Program in collaboration with the Harris County Office of Transit Services Division. Together the City of Baytown and Harris County can provide two transportation options under the Rides Program and Harris County Transit. The goal of the Program is to provide eligible residents with non-emergency transportation services within the city limits of Baytown and to/from Houston for medical appointments.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be a resident of the City of Baytown;
2. Applicants must be 62 years of age or older, have a certified disability, or receive a referral for domestic violence/sexual assault;
3. All members of applicant's household must be legal residents of the United States; and
4. Applicant's household annual gross income must not exceed the below-stated maximum income limits.
