

PREFACE

This proposed ordinance authorizes the First Amendment to the 2018-19 Tourism Partnership Grant Agreement with Highlands Sports Association concerning its basketball tournament to change the dates of the tournament.

On February 28, 2019, \$8,000 was approved for the Association to hold a basketball tournament to be held on April 19 - 21, 2019. Due to unforeseen circumstances this event was canceled and the Association proposes to hold, in its place a basketball symposium, camp and tournament from August 30 to September 2, 2019.
